EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1985, A VENDOR'S FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (NUMBER ASSIGNED WHEN FILING INCOME TAX DOCUMENTS) OR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IF VENDOR IS AN INDIVIDUAL, MUST BE ON ALL CONTRACTS. DOCUMENTS AND INVOICES SUBMITTED TO THE COMMONWEALTH.

Act 266 of 1982 provides for the payment of interest penalties on certain invoices of "qualified small business concerns". The penalties apply to invoices for goods or services when payments are not made by the required payment date or within a 15 day grace period thereafter.

Act 1984-196 redefined a "qualified small business concern" as any independently owned and operated, for-profit business concern employing 100 or fewer employees. See 4 Pa. Code \S 2.32. The business must include the following statement on every invoice submitted to the Commonwealth: "(name of business) is a qualified small business concern as defined in 4 Pa. Code 2.32."

A business is eligible for payments when the required payment is the latest of:

The payment date specified in the contract.

30 days after the later of the receipt of a proper invoice or receipt of goods or services.

The net payment date stated on the business' invoice.

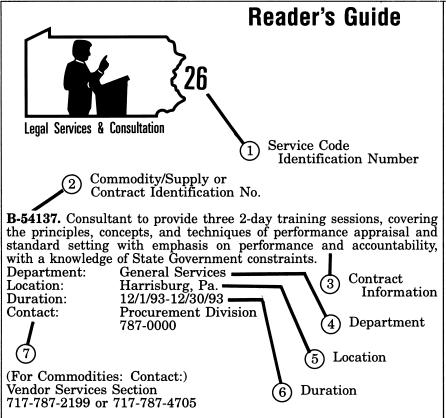
A 15-day grace period after the required payment date is provided to the Commonwealth by the Act.

New Act 57 Thresholds Effective January 1, 2002

Act 57 of 1998 provides for annual adjustments to certain thresholds to reflect the annual percentage change in the Composite Construction Cost Index of the United States Department of Commerce occurring in the 1-year period ending December 31 of each year. The Composite Construction Cost Index for the year ending December 31, 1997, was 103.3. The Composite Construction Cost Index for the year ending December 31, 2001, was 119. The difference between the indices for calendar years 1997 and 2001 is 15.7. Therefore, the percentage change in the Composite Construction Cost Index from 1997 to 2000 is 15.1984%. Using this adjustment percentage, the new dollar thresholds for calendar year 2002 follows. The chart also shows the dollar thresholds for each intervening year.
