Rendell, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby convene the General Assembly in Special and Extraordinary Session, to meet in the Capitol at Harrisburg, on Monday, September 17, 2007, at 11 a.m., to consider any and all legislation regarding funding for and the making of investments in clean and renewable energy, energy conservation and economic development efforts relating thereto, and the establishment of requirements regarding the renewable energy content of liquid fuels.
