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CHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

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§ 1.1. Scope of part.

This part relates to the functions of the Legislative Reference Bureau as a supporting agency of the General Assembly. The regulations relating to the functions of the Bureau as the publisher of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* and *Pennsylvania Code* under the Commonwealth Documents Law (45 P. S. § 1101 et seq.) and exercised through the Documents Law Section are set out in 1 Pa. Code Part I (relating to Joint Committee on Documents).
